Over the past 25 years she has recorded 109 species of birds in the Sleeping Lady area, which is documented in the Citizen Science eBird program at Cornell Lab of Ornithology. Breeding season Bird Walks at Sleeping Lady are an excellent opportunity to observe an abundance of species. Meet at the gazebo in the organic garden at Sleeping Lady. Bring your binoculars and join in for the full hour and a half walk, a shortened version, or as your day allows.
